- Union took the lead in the 82nd minute. Substitute Antoine Hoppenot kept the ball alive along the end line and drove it toward goal. After the ball bounced off a defender and goalkeeper Donovan Ricketts, Lionard Pajoy banged home the loose ball right in front of goal.
- But the Impact leveled the score just seven minutes later after a Patrice Bernier corner kick bounced off the head of Union midfielder Keon Daniel and into the goal.
- But the home side netted the winner in stoppage time. Sheanon Williams sent in a long throw-in from the right flank, the ball bounced off a defender, and captain Carlos Valdés pounced it and drove into the goal for the decider. Davy Arnaud and Felipe came back into the team in place of Lamar Neagle and Sanna Nyassi.

MONTREAL IMPACT

The Montréal Impact won their third consecutive home match, defeating the New York Red Bulls 3-1 on Saturday evening at Stade Saputo. The Impact are in seventh place in the Eastern Conference with 27 points from 24 matches.

LAST MATCH

- The Impact broke open the match early in the second half. First, in the 48th minute, Justin Mapp completed a passing movement with a first-time to an unmarked Marco Di Vaio on the left side of the area, and he put a low finish past New York goalkeeper Bill Gaudette.
- The lead was doubled two minutes later when Felipe sent Davy Arnaud through behind the New York backline and in alone on goal. The Red Bulls 'keeper did get a hand to the Impact skipper's shot, but it ultimately found the back of the net.

- New York pulled a goal back in the 57th minute when Joel Lindpere got to the endline and pulled a cross back for Thierry Henry at the far post, and he lofted a gentle touch over Impact 'keeper Donovan Ricketts as he came off his line.
- But Montreal restored their cushion in the 75th minute when Sanna Nyassi capped another passing sequence by rounding Gaudette deep in the area and sliding home from a tight angle.
- Impact head coach Jesse Marsch made five changes to the team that fell 3-0 to the Houston Dynamo at BBVA Compass Stadium. Alessandro Nesta, Nelson Rivas and Jeb Brovsky came into the back four for Zarek Valentin, Shavar Thomas and Dennis Iapichino, and Collen Warner and Justin Mapp came into the midfield for Lamar and Sanna Nyassi.

TEAM NEWS

- The Impact have now reeled off three consecutive victories at Stade Saputo, but they have lost their last five away matches. They have not recorded a draw since May 12 (13 matches).
- Despite some of the results recently on the road, there has been positive momentum in the team. If the Philly or Houston games go a bit differently, we may have different results," said Impact head coach Jesse Marsch. "We are getting some guys healthy and that helps with confidence as we have everyone ready for us."
- Making his eighth appearance for the Impact and his sixth consecutive start, Marco Di Vaio finally opened his MLS goalscoring account with the opening goal.
- "I felt really happy for him," Alessandro Nesta said. "It's been a few games already and he hadn't scored, but he finally has, and in a very important game against New York."
- Nesta also made his MLS debut, the Italy World Cup winner starting in central defense alongside Nelson Rivas.
- "Everything that you see in him is that he is real. The way he sees plays to the way he talks to his teammates. His leadership and the knowledge of what it takes to win will help this team. He showed as the game went on that he was getting stronger," said Marsch.
- Rivas returned to the lineup for the first time since June 23, missing seven matches with an abdominal strain.
- "It doesn't take away from anything that Shavar [Thomas] or Hassoun [Camara] did when they played in there, but those guys help settle the game down and make sense of things for us," Marsch said.
- Felipe recorded his first career three-assist game in MLS, and has six assists in the last nine games. His eight assists for the season rank sixth in MLS, two off the league lead held by D.C. United's Dwayne De Rosario and Houston's Brad Davis.
- "That's the position where I need to play, because I have more space and I am free to move to both sides, to drop deeper, to go higher," Felipe said. "I feel better when I play there, but if the coach plays me as a 'keeper, I'll play."
- While he went back to the substitutes' bench following two consecutive starts, Sanna Nyassi scored his second goal in three games.
- "That's what a deep team is all about," Nyassi said. "It doesn't matter who starts. Whenever you start, or you come on as a sub, you help your team win in any way possible. And that's what I did – I complemented the effort that my team put in. They had a great first half, and I just came in the second half [and] put the game away."

PHILADELPHIA UNION

Philadelphia Union once again provided some dramatics for a victory, getting a late game-winner for a 2-1 win against the New England Revolution on Sunday evening at PPL Park. Union are in a tie for eighth place in the Eastern Conference with 23 points from 19 games.

LAST MATCH

- The Revolution opened the scoring in the 12th minute. Saer Sène collected the ball in midfield fired a blast from distance that knuckled past confused Union goalkeeper Zac MacMath.
- But Union pulled level in the 59th minute when Freddy Adu banged home a penalty kick, after New England's Kevin Alston was whistled for a foul for taking down Jack McInerney right at the edge of the 18-yard box.
- McInerney then completed the Union comeback in the 90th minute, waiting at the back post to head home a cross from Sheanon Williams that sailed over New England goalkeeper Matt Reis for the match-winner.
- Union interim manager John Hackworth made three changes to the team that fell to a 2-0 defeat by the New York Red Bulls at Red Bull Arena. Gabriel Gomez, Antoine Hoppenot and Freddy Adu all came into the side, in place of Josue Martinez, Michael Lahoud and Lionard Pajoy.

TEAM NEWS

- It was the first time, in 11 games where they've conceded the opening goal, Union came back to secure a victory (they had just one tie in the previous 10). Only Seattle Sounders FC have yet to win after allowing the opening goal this season.
- "We have another first in our season, and that's really important, because to be at this point in our season, and not even to come back to get a result," said Union head coach John Hackworth. "To do it in the fashion that we did, and get a win and three points, it's huge. So I think you see the character of these players."
- For the third time since Hackworth took over as head coach, Union won with the match-winning goal coming in the 90th minute or later.
- "Proves our team has fight. It's going to be a fight the rest of the season. Those are the kind of games we need to win," said defender Sheanon Williams. "Those are games maybe in the beginning of the season that maybe didn't go our way and now are starting to fall our way. So we'll take all the points we can get right now."
- Union have now won five of their last seven games, yet have only moved from sole possession of ninth place in the Eastern Conference to a tie for eighth place with New England.
- "We talked about before the game that we wanted to move up in the standings and we did that," said Williams. "We got a lot of games on Montreal. I think it's four right now. So we're on their back and we're coming for their spot. And we're on a good run and hopefully we'll continue that."
- Making his fifth consecutive start in attack and his seventh in eight games since Hackworth took over, Jack McInerney scored his fourth goal – his first since July 4.
- Freddy Adu returned to the lineup after a one-match absence and converted the penalty kick for the opening goal, his second goal in four games.
- "I think the fact that he trained hard all week and that he was really good and that he played really well tonight says a lot more for me than if he scores a goal or not," Hackworth said. "We need Freddy to be important for our team if we're going to be successful."
- Rookie Antoine Hoppenot made his first career MLS start, after coming off the substitutes' bench for eight consecutive matches.
- "It was a little different. This was his first start. The chemistry wasn't always there, but we found some good spots and I think we worked well off each other," said McInerney. "If we get a couple more games, we're just going to get better."
- "A guy like Antoine did really well in his first start, but now we're going away and playing in a very tough environment against a team that has been very good at home," Hackworth said. "So we have to think about what can allow us the chance to have the most success there."

PROFIL DES JOUEURS // PLAYER PROFILES

#1 DONOVAN RICKETTS G/GK

• Donovan Ricketts, 34 ans, a remporté la Coupe MLS avec le LA Galaxy en 2011. L'international jamaïcain a disputé 15 des 34 matchs du club, enregistrant sept blanchissages et une moyenne de 0,77 but par match. Lors de ses deux précédentes saisons avec le Galaxy, il a été finaliste au titre de Gardien le plus utile de la ligue en 2009, avant de remporter le titre en 2010. Il a aussi été nommé sur le Meilleur XI cette année-là, et a débuté dans les buts lors du Match des étoiles de la MLS contre Manchester United. Ricketts entreprendra sa quatrième saison dans la MLS, après avoir été acquis par l'Impact de Montréal le 28 novembre contre une allocation monétaire. / *Donovan Ricketts, 34, won the 2011 MLS Cup with the LA Galaxy. The Jamaican international played in 15 of the club's 34 games, recording seven shutouts and had a 0.77 goals-against average. In his previous two years with the Galaxy, he was runner-up for the 2009 MLS Goalkeeper of the Year award and took home the title in 2010. He was also named a member of the league's Best XI that year, earning the start in goal for the MLS All-Star team that faced Manchester United. This will be his fourth season in MLS, acquired by the Montreal Impact on November 28 for allocation money.*

#2 NELSON RIVAS D

• Nelson Rivas est devenu le premier joueur à se joindre à l'Impact pour la MLS le 2 octobre 2011. Rivas, 28 ans, a appartenu au prestigieux club italien Internazionale Milano, de 2007 à 2011. Il a fait ses débuts avec Inter lors d'un match de la Ligue des Champions contre Fenerbahçe, le 19 septembre 2007. Lors de son séjour avec le club italien, il a affronté plusieurs grandes équipes de renommées internationales, dont Manchester United lors d'un match de la Ligue des Champions en 2009. Son dernier match en sol italien a eu lieu le 12 janvier 2011 en Coppa Italia dans une victoire contre Genoa. Le joueur colombien a aussi évolué avec le club argentin River Plate. / *Nelson Rivas was the Impact's first ever signing on October 2. Rivas, 28, belonged to the prestigious Italian first division club Internazionale Milano, from 2007 to 2011. He made his debut with Inter during a Champions League match versus Fenerbahçe, on September 19, 2007. During his time with Inter, he played against several top teams in the world including a Champions League match against Manchester United in 2009. His most recent game with Inter was played on January 12, 2011 in a Coppa Italia win versus Genoa. The Colombian has also spent time with top club River Plate in Argentina.*

#3 SHAVAR THOMAS D

• Shavar Thomas, 30 ans, a disputé plus de 170 matchs dans la MLS, dont 158 comme partant, enregistrant trois buts et une passe. Il totalise plus de 13 000 minutes de jeu en carrière, et a notamment remporté la Coupe des États-Unis Lamar Hunt avec KC en 2004. Il est présentement le capitaine de l'équipe nationale de la Jamaïque, ayant disputé 43 matchs depuis 1999. Il s'est joint à l'Impact le 20 janvier 2012. / *Shavar Thomas, 30, has played 170 career MLS games, including 158 as a starter, recording three goals and one assist. He has logged more than 13,000 minutes of play in his MLS career, and has most notably won the 2004 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup with KC. He is the current captain of the Jamaican National Team, making 43 appearances since 1999. He was signed by the Impact on January 20, 2012.*



#6 HASSOUN CAMARA D

• Hassoun Camara a été nommé Joueur le plus utile de l'Impact lors de sa première saison à Montréal en 2011. Le joueur de 27 ans a aussi été sélectionné sur l'équipe d'étoiles de la NASL. Camara a terminé en tête de l'équipe avec 22 départs en 22 matchs (1949 minutes de jeu). Il a aussi enregistré deux buts et une passe pour un total de cinq points. Camara a appartenu à l'Olympique de Marseille, en première division française, en 2006 et 2007. / *Hassoun Camara, 27, in his first season with the Impact in the NASL, was named the team's most valuable player in 2011. He was also selected to the league's Best XI Team. Camara finished tops on the team with 22 starts in 22 games (1949 minutes played). He also tallied two goals and one assist for a total of five points. Camara belonged to French first division club l'Olympique de Marseille in 2006 and 2007.*

#7 FELIPE M

• Felipe, 21 ans, s'est joint à l'Impact le 21 décembre. Il a disputé 75 matchs en quatre saisons dans la Challenge League, en deuxième division suisse, avec FC Winterthur, FC Wohlen, et principalement FC Lugano, avec qui il a marqué sept buts en 50 matchs, dont 32 comme partant. / *Felipe, 21, joined the Impact on December 21 after playing 75 games in four seasons in the Challenge League, the Swiss second division, with FC Winterthur, FC Wohlen, and mainly with FC Lugano over that span, scoring a total of seven goals in 50 games for them, 32 as a starter.*

#8 PATRICE BERNIER M

• Patrice Bernier effectue un retour dans l'organisation de l'Impact, après avoir porté les couleurs du club de 2000 à 2002. Présentement membre de l'équipe nationale du Canada avec 47 apparitions, il a disputé neuf saisons en Europe avec les clubs Moss F.K. et Tromsø IL en Norvège, FC Kaiserslautern en Allemagne, ainsi que FC Nordsjælland et Lyngby BK au Danemark. En 2005, le Québécois a participé à six matchs de la UEFA Cup, aidant Tromsø IL à battre le géant turc Galatasaray S.K. lors de la première ronde, avant de participer à la phase de groupe contre le RC Strasbourg (France), l'A.S. Roma (Italie), le FC Basel (Suisse) et le Red Star Belgrade (Serbie). / *Patrice Bernier makes his return with the Impact, previously wearing the team's colours from 2000-2002. A current Canadian National Team member with 47 caps, he's played nine seasons in Europe with Moss F.K and Tromsø IL in Norway, FC Kaiserslautern in Germany, as well as FC Nordsjælland and Lyngby BK in Denmark. In 2005, the Quebec native played in six UEFA Cup matches, helping Tromsø IL beat Turkish giants Galatasaray S.K. in the first round before playing in the group stage against RC Strasbourg (France), A.S. Roma (Italy), FC Basel (Switzerland) and Red Star Belgrade (Serbia).*

#9 MARCO DI VAIO A/F – JOUEUR DÉSIGNÉ / DESIGNATED PLAYER

• Marco Di Vaio est devenu le tout premier Joueur Désigné de l'histoire du club en Major League Soccer le 24 mai. Âgé de 35 ans, il est l'un des meilleurs buteurs de l'histoire de la première division italienne, avec 142 buts en 342 matchs de Serie A, avec la Lazio, Bari, Salernitana, Parme, la Juventus, Genoa et plus récemment Bologne, au cours des quatre dernières années. Di Vaio a aussi évolué avec l'AS Monaco, en Ligue 1 en France, et Genoa, en première et deuxième division italienne. Au niveau international, Di Vaio a marqué deux buts en 14 matchs avec l'équipe nationale italienne. Il a disputé plusieurs matchs amicaux de 2001 à 2004, notamment contre les États-Unis, l'Uruguay et l'Espagne, et a participé à l'Euro 2004. Il a aussi joué un match de qualification de la Coupe du Monde 2006 de la FIFA. / *Marco Di Vaio became the club's first ever Designated Player in Major League Soccer on May 24, 2012. Di Vaio, 35, is one of the greatest goal scorers in the history of first division soccer in Italy, with 142 goals in 342 games played in Serie A, with Lazio, Bari, Salernitana, Parma, Juventus, Genoa and most recently Bologna, for the last four seasons. Prior to joining Bologna, he played with AS Monaco, in France's Ligue 1, and with Genoa, in the first and second division in Italy. On the international stage, Di Vaio scored two goals in 14 games played with the Italian National Team. He played a number of friendlies from 2001-2004, most notably against the U.S., Uruguay and Spain. He was also a member of Italy's 2004 Euro squad, which included the Impact's Bernardo Corradi and Matteo Ferrari. He also played in a FIFA World Cup qualifier in 2006.*

#11 SANNA NYASSI A/F-M

• Sanna Nyassi a joué 26 matchs (1586 minutes de jeu) en 2011 avec les Colorado Rapids, enregistrant cinq buts et cinq passes, dont un tour du chapeau contre les New York Red Bulls le 20 juillet. Il a inscrit sept buts et huit mentions d'aide en 64 matchs en carrière dans la MLS, au cours de trois saisons avec le Colorado et Seattle. Il a aussi représenté la Gambie au niveau international à plusieurs niveaux, participant notamment aux matchs de qualification pour la Coupe d'Afrique en 2012. / *Sanna Nyassi played 26 games (1,586 minutes of play) in 2011 with the Colorado Rapids, registering five goals and five assists, including a hat trick, against the New York Red Bulls on July 20. He has totalled seven goals and eight assists in 64 career MLS games over three seasons with Colorado and Seattle. He has also represented the Gambian national team at several levels, including African Cup qualifying matches in 2012.*



#13 MATTEO FERRARI D

• Matteo Ferrari s'est officiellement joint à l'Impact le 1^{er} mars, suite à un court essai avec le club. Le défenseur âgé de 32 ans a passé les deux dernières saisons avec Besiktas, club de première division turque, auquel il s'était joint en 2009 et avec qui il a remporté une Coupe de Turquie en 2011. Ferrari a également joué plus de 200 matchs et plus de 20 000 minutes en Serie A (Italie), plus particulièrement avec l'Inter Milan, Parme et l'AS Rome. Durant ces années, il a remporté trois Coupes d'Italie et une SuperCoupe. Ferrari a pris part à 22 matchs de la Ligue des Champions UEFA, dont 19 à titre de titulaire, en plus des 21 matchs en Coupe UEFA. Au niveau international, il a pris part à 11 matchs avec la sélection nationale italienne et 33 avec les Espoirs. Ferrari était de l'équipe nationale des moins de 21 lors de l'Euro 2002 UEFA et il a également représenté l'Italie lors des Jeux Olympiques d'été de 2000 et de 2004, remportant la médaille bronze à Athènes, en Grèce. Le défenseur central faisait partie de l'équipe nationale lors de l'Euro 2004 UEFA. / *Matteo Ferrari officially joined the Impact on March 1, following a short trial with the club. The 32-year-old spent the last two seasons with first division Turkish club Besiktas, joining the side in 2009 and winning the Turkish Cup in 2011. Prior to that, Ferrari played in more than 200 games and over 20,000 minutes in Italy's Serie A, most notably with Inter Milan, Parma, and AS Roma. During his time there, he won three Italian Cups and one Italian Super Cup. In addition, he has played 22 Champions League games, 19 as a starter, to go along with 21 UEFA Cup appearances. Ferrari has played 11 games for the Italian National Team and has 33 caps as a national youth team member. He was also part of the UEFA Euro 2002 U21 squad and played in the 2000 and 2004 Summer Olympic Games, winning a bronze medal in Athens, Greece. The central defender was also in the squad that participated at the UEFA Euro 2004.*

#14 ALESSANDRO NESTA D

• Alessandro Nesta, qui a joué 20 ans en première division italienne et qui a remporté la Coupe du monde de la FIFA en 2006, s'est joint à l'Impact le 5 juillet 2012. Nesta a disputé un grand total de 417 matchs en Série A, 101 matchs en Ligue des Champions de l'UEFA, 17 matchs en Coupe UEFA/Europa et 17 matchs de la Coupe d'Italie, sous les couleurs de la Lazio de Rome, de 1993 à 2002, puis de l'AC Milan, de 2002 à 2012. Il est considéré comme l'un des meilleurs défenseurs centraux dans l'histoire du soccer. Il a notamment été sélectionné à quatre reprises sur l'Équipe de l'année de l'UEFA (2002, 2003, 2004 et 2007) et nommé quatre fois Défenseur par excellence de la Série A (2000, 2001, 2002 et 2003). Avant de rejoindre l'Impact, il a débuté 16 de ses 17 matchs avec l'AC Milan lors de la saison 2011-2012, marquant un but, en plus de jouer sept matchs de la Ligue des Champions de l'UEFA, dont deux en phase de groupe et deux en quarts-de-finale contre le FC Barcelone. Au niveau international, Nesta a joué 78 matchs avec l'équipe nationale de l'Italie remportant la Coupe du Monde de la FIFA en 2006. Il a aussi participé à la Coupe du Monde de la FIFA en 1998 et 2002, ainsi qu'à l'Euro en 2000 et 2004. / *Alessandro Nesta, who played 20 years in Italy's first division and who won the FIFA World Cup in 2006, signed with the Impact on July 5, 2012. Nesta played a total of 417 games in Serie A, 101 games in Champions League competition, 17 UEFA Cup/Europa matches and 17 Coppa Italia contests, all while wearing the uniforms of Lazio from 1993-2002, and AC Milan from 2003-2012. He is considered one of the all-time best central defenders in soccer history. He was named to the UEFA Team of the Year on four occasions (2002, 2003, 2004, and 2007) and was named Serie A Defender of the Year another four times (2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003). Before joining the Impact, he started 16 of 17 games played during the 2011-2012 season and scored one goal, while appearing in seven UEFA Champions League games; two in group phase and two in the quarterfinals against FC Barcelona. At the international level, Nesta played 78 times with the Italian National Team as a central defender, winning the prestigious FIFA World Cup in 2006 against France. He also took part in the 1998 and 2002 World Cups.*

#15 JEB BROVSKY D

• Jeb Brovsky s'est joint aux Vancouver Whitecaps FC après avoir été choisi avec le premier choix de la deuxième ronde (19e au total) lors du SuperDraft 2011 de la MLS. Le joueur américain de 23 ans a disputé 24 matchs (1509 minutes de jeu) pour Vancouver lors de sa saison recrue, après une brillante carrière universitaire avec l'Université de Notre Dame. Il a été acquis par l'Impact de Montréal lors du repêchage d'expansion. / *Jeb Brovsky joined the Vancouver Whitecaps FC after being selected as the first pick in the second round (19th overall) of the 2011 MLS SuperDraft. The 23-year-old American played in 24 games (1,509 minutes played) for Vancouver in his rookie season following a stellar college career with the University of Notre Dame. He joined the Impact on November 23 via the 2012 Expansion draft.*

#16 EDUARDO SEBRANGO A/F

• Eduardo Sebrango s'est entendu avec l'Impact le 21 février après un essai réussi avec le club de la MLS. Le joueur de 38 ans est un des attaquants les plus titrés dans l'histoire de la deuxième division nord-américaine, remportant cinq championnats, soit deux avec l'Impact en 2004 et 2009, deux avec Vancouver en 2006 et 2008, et un avec les Rhinos de Rochester en 2000. Il est présentement au deuxième rang dans l'histoire de la deuxième division nord-américaine avec 104 buts, 31 passes et 239 points en 270 matchs et 18 430 minutes de jeu. / *Eduardo Sebrango signed with the Impact on February 21 following a trial with the MLS club. The 38-year-old is one of the most successful players in the history of second division soccer in North America, winning five championships, two with the Impact in 2004 and 2009, and two with Vancouver in 2006 and 2008, as well as one with the Rochester Rhinos in 2000. He currently ranks second place all-time in North American second division scoring, with a total of 104 goals, 31 assists for 239 points in 270 games and 18,430 minutes of play.*

#17 DENNIS IAPICHINO D

• Dennis Iapichino, 21 ans, s'est joint à l'Impact le 11 juillet 2012 après avoir été formé par le FC Basel, un des plus prestigieux clubs de première division suisse, prenant part à 29 matchs avec l'équipe des moins de 21 ans en 2008/2009 et 2009/2010. Iapichino a ensuite disputé plus de 50 matchs en Challenge League, en deuxième division suisse. Au niveau international, il a participé à six matchs amicaux avec l'équipe nationale des moins de 20 ans de la Suisse. / *Dennis Iapichino, 21, joined the Impact on July 11, 2012, after spending much of his development years with FC Basel, one of the most prestigious clubs in the Swiss first division, playing 29 games with the Under-21 team in 2008/2009 and 2009/2010. Iapichino then played more than 50 games in the Challenge League, the country's second division. Internationally, he took part in six friendly games with the Swiss U20 National Team.*



#18 COLLEN WARNER M

• Collen Warner a disputé 37 matchs dans l'uniforme du Real Salt Lake en deux saisons dans la MLS. Il a connu sa meilleure campagne en 2011 avec cinq mentions d'aide en 24 matchs (1106 minutes de jeu), dont 15 comme partant. Il a aussi participé à trois matchs de la Ligue des Champions de la CONCACAF, enregistrant un but et une passe. Le joueur de 23 ans a été acquis par l'Impact de Montréal lors du repêchage d'expansion. / *Collen Warner appeared in 37 games for Real Salt Lake in his first two seasons in MLS. The 2011 season was a breakout year for Warner as he totaled five assists in 24 games (1,106 minutes played), including 15 as a starter. He also appeared in three CONCACAF Champions League games for RSL, scoring one goal and one assist. The 23-year-old was acquired by the Impact via the expansion draft.*

#19 ZAREK VALENTIN D

• Zarek Valentin a été repêché en première ronde, quatrième au total, par Chivas USA lors du SuperDraft 2011 de la MLS. Valentin a disputé 25 matchs (2114 minutes de jeu) lors de sa première saison dans la MLS. Il fait présentement partie de l'équipe nationale des moins de 23 ans des États-Unis qui tentera prochainement de se qualifier pour les Jeux olympiques de Londres 2012. Il a été acquis par l'Impact de Montréal lors du repêchage d'expansion. / *Zarek Valentin was drafted in the first round, fourth overall, in the 2011 MLS SuperDraft, by Chivas USA. Valentin played in 25 games (2,114 minutes played) in his first season in MLS. He is currently a member of the U.S. U23 National Team that hopes to qualify for the 2012 Olympics in London. He was acquired by the Montreal Impact via the expansion draft.*

#21 JUSTIN MAPP M

• Justin Mapp a été nommé sur l'équipe des Meilleurs XI de la MLS en 2006. Il a inscrit 18 buts en 221 matchs en carrière dans la MLS depuis 2002, avec D.C. United, le Chicago Fire et le Philadelphia Union, et a remporté la Coupe des États-Unis Lamar Hunt en 2003 et 2006. Il a aussi participé à huit matchs avec l'équipe nationale des États-Unis, remportant la Gold Cup de la CONCACAF en 2007. Il a été acquis par l'Impact de Montréal lors du repêchage d'expansion. / *Justin Mapp was named to the MLS Best XI squad in 2006. He has scored 18 goals in 221 career games in MLS since 2002, with D.C. United, the Chicago Fire and the Philadelphia Union, and won the 2003 and 2006 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup. He has also appeared in eight games for the U.S. National Team, winning the CONCACAF Gold Cup in 2007. He was acquired by the Montreal Impact via the expansion draft.*

#22 DAVY ARNAUD M

• Davy Arnaud est devenu le premier capitaine de l'Impact de Montréal en MLS le 6 mars. Il a été acquis par l'Impact dans un échange le 28 novembre en retour du choix d'expansion Seth Sinovic et une allocation monétaire. Arnaud, un vétéran de 31 ans, a servi à titre de capitaine du Sporting Kansas City en 2010 et 2011. Il a disputé 10 saisons avec KC, jouant dans plus de 240 matchs, un record d'équipe, et est prêt d'atteindre le plateau des 20 000 minutes de jeu en carrière. Il a jusqu'à présent marqué 43 buts et ajouté 35 mentions d'aide. Il a disputé 15 matchs en séries éliminatoires, en plus de remporter la Coupe des États-Unis Lamar Hunt et le Championnat de l'Association Ouest en 2004. Il a joué sept matchs avec l'équipe nationale des États-Unis, étant notamment un finaliste lors de la Gold Cup de la CONCACAF en 2009. / *Davy Arnaud was named the first ever captain of the Montreal Impact in MLS on March 6. He was acquired in a trade from Sporting KC on November 28 for expansion pick Seth Sinovic and allocation money. Arnaud, a 31-year-old league veteran, served as captain of KC in 2010 and 2011. He played 10 seasons with KC, appearing in over 240 games, a club record, and is inching towards 20,000 minutes played. He scored 43 goals and added 35 assist over that span. He appeared in 15 career playoff games, as well as winning the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup and the Western Conference Championship in 2004. He played in seven games for the U.S. National Team, including as a finalist in the 2009 Gold Cup tournament.*

#23 BERNARDO CORRADI A/F

• Corradi s'est officiellement joint à l'Impact le 15 mars. Le joueur de 35 ans a joué plus de 250 matchs en Serie A, plus particulièrement avec Chievo Verona, Lazio et Udinese. Il a marqué 68 buts en première division italienne, en plus de remporter une SuperCoupe d'Europe et une Coupe d'Italie, en 2004. Corradi a également joué en Liga (Espagne) avec Valence en 2004-2005, et avec le club de Premier League Manchester City en 2006-2007. Corradi a marqué deux buts en 13 matchs avec l'équipe nationale d'Italie, en 2003 et 2004, en plus de faire partie de l'effectif qui a pris part à l'Euro de l'UEFA en 2004. / *Corradi joined the Impact on March 15. The 35-year-old has over 250 games experience in Serie A, most notably with Chievo Verona, Lazio and Udinese. He's scored 68 goals over that span, winning a European Super Cup and a Coppa Italia in 2004. He's appeared in one Champions League game with Inter and eight UEFA Cup games with Lazio, scoring one goal. Corradi also played in Spain's La Liga with Valencia in 2004-2005 and had a spell with Manchester City in the English Premier League in 2006-2007. At the international level, he's made 13 appearances for the Italian National Team in 2003 and 2004, scoring two goals, and was a member of Italy's UEFA Euro 2004 squad.*



#24 GREG SUTTON G/GK

MLS ALL-STAR GAME AT PPL PARK

The 2012 MLS All-Star Game was hosted in PPL Park on Wednesday in front of a record breaking crowd of 19,236.

Seattle Sounders striker Eddie Johnson's scored the winning goal off a deflection in the first minute of second-half stoppage time giving the All-Stars of the MLS a dramatic 3-2 win over visiting Chelsea FC.

Johnson – who last played in an All-Star Game while with the Kansas City Wizards in 2007, before a four-year stint in Europe that included time facing Chelsea while with Fulham – ripped a right-footed shot from the top of the box that skipped off the outstretched leg of Chelsea defender David Luiz and past helpless goalkeeper Ross Turnbull for the winner.

The goal punctuated a gutsy effort from the All-Stars, who found themselves in trouble early in the second half after Chelsea's Frank Lampard put the Blues up 2-1 in the 58th minute. Despite being down, D.C. United forward Chris Pontius leveled the score in the 71st minute and an MLS defense led by Vancouver's Jay DeMerit held on just long enough to set the stage for heroics for the second-half sub Johnson.

The All-Stars topped Chelsea for the second time in as many tries with the win, following a 1-0 upset over a star-studded Chelsea roster in 2006 at Toyota Park in Bridgeview, Ill. The win also eased at least a bit of tension for MLS, which for the past two years saw the All-Stars crumble against high-powered teams from Manchester United.

Pontius, who made his first appearance in the All-Star Game, was named MVP of the match out of the MLS All-Stars.

UNION INVOLVEMENT IN 2012 ALL-STAR GAME

The Philadelphia Union hosted the 2012 AT&T All-Star Game at PPL Park on Wednesday. Three members of the Philadelphia Union were members of the MLS team that defeated the European Champions, Chelsea FC, 3-2. Union interim manager John Hackworth was an assistant coach under D.C. United head coach Ben Olsen. Defender Carlos Valdes was a commissioner's pick, while midfielder Michael Farfan was a late addition to the MLS roster. Farfan was added to the roster as an additional substitute requested by Chelsea FC.

Valdes and Farfan both reflected on their first All-Star experiences. "It's awesome playing with [Thierry] Henry, [David] Beckham, [Landon] Donovan and the rest of the teammates," Valdes said. "It's amazing. One of the best minutes of my life. I'm really proud to be part of this game, of this great family. I'm really excited." Farfan spoke after the game about his experience of appearing in his first All-Star game. "It was exciting. It's something that we dream of as kids, to play against the European champions," said Farfan. "It's an amazing feeling, especially to do it at home in front of the Sons of Ben, and all of our friends and family."

Interim manager and All-Star assistant coach John Hackworth spoke about his experience as a coach for the game. "What a great night for Philadelphia, our fans in particular, a lot show up here each week and come see an All-Star game. To see them come cheer on their hometown heroes was fantastic."

Hackworth spoke about the reaction from the crowd towards Valdes and Farfan. "When both of them starting warming up, the crowd starting chanting, you got goose bumps, so it was awesome."

NEVER TOO LATE FOR A GOAL

The Union, as of late, have been great at scoring goals. Scoring goals in stoppage time that is. Three out of the last seven goals have come in stoppage time of either halves. The first stoppage time goal came against the LA Galaxy with Jack McInerney's "MLS Goal of the Week" victory with a back heel goal in the 46th minute.

The second stoppage time goal came in the same game when midfielder Michael Farfan received an outstanding back heel flick from Lionard Pajoy and buried his shot for a goal to the far post. This was the deciding factor in the game and gave the Union their first win against the LA Galaxy in franchise history.

The third goal in stoppage time was just as spectacular as the two before it. After a hard fought 90 minutes of play and the game tied 1-1 versus the Montreal Impact the Union had one last chance to clinch three points. The set piece was started with a long throw-in from Sheanon Williams from the out-of-bounds position, in line with the upper 18. The throw in grazed the head of an Impact defender directly inside the goalie box and behind Union defender Carlos Valdes. The captain, aware of his positioning, turned and buried the game winner past the goalie giving the Union their third straight win and another stoppage time victory.

PLAYOFF PUSH

The Philadelphia Union moved into a tie for eighth place in the Eastern Conference with the New England Revolution (23pts). The Union defeated the Revolution 2-1 on July 29. Philadelphia enters the match against Montreal within four points of the Impact with five games in hand.

The Union have gained 12 points from a possible 15 in July. The only teams that have more points in their last six MLS games are the Houston Dynamo (14pts) and LA Galaxy (13pts).

The Union are eight points from the play-offs with at least two games in-hand over all but Columbus Crew, whom both have played 19 games.

RESERVE GAME ANNOUNCED

The Philadelphia Union announced that they will host D.C. United in a reserve league match on October 9 at 3:30. The match will take place at Chester Park in Swarthmore, Pa. This match was originally schedule to be played on June 5, at the DCU training field. The next match for the reserve team will be on August 5 against the Montreal Impact at Saputo Stadium.

HOME WIN STREAK

Last Sunday's victory over the New England Revolution set a franchise record for most consecutive home wins at PPL Park. The Union broke the previous record set in 2010 and 2011, which was set at two home victories, when they defeated the Montreal Impact 2-1, on July 14.

The previous record was set three times at two consecutive games, once in 2010 and twice in 2011. In the later months of the 2010 season, the Union defeated the Chicago Fire 1-0, just days before defeating Chivas USA, 3-0 at PPL Park. The first home win streak in 2011, started the season off with the Union defeating Vancouver Whitecaps 1-0 on March 26. After a short trip out to Los Angeles, the Union returned home to defeat the New York Red Bulls, 1-0, on April 9. The second streak in 2011 occurred with the Union defeating the Columbus Crew, 1-0 on September 17. Two weeks later, the Union defeated D.C. United 3-2, on September 29.

FIRST INTERNATIONAL MATCH LOST AT PPL PARK

For the first time, the Union lost in an international match at PPL Park as English club Aston Villa came away with a 1-0 victory behind Nathan Delfouneso's 43rd-minute goal and Villa's stalwart defensive play. The Union have a 1-2 record when facing EPL opponents.

The Union's first EPL challenge as a club was a respectable 2-1 loss versus Manchester United. The second challenge came against Everton where youth standout Christian Hernandez sealed the win for Philadelphia in the 71 minute.

Against Aston Villa, as halftime approached, Delfouneso finally broke the deadlock. The forward settled a pass from Holman just outside the Union box and put a hard strike on goal out of the reach of a diving MacMath to give Aston Villa the 1-0 advantage, a lead that manager Paul Lambert's club would not surrender.

UNION TO BROADCAST ON 610 WIP

The Philadelphia Union's inaugural radio game broadcast kicked off on SportsRadio 610 WIP against Eastern Conference rival New York Red Bulls at Red Bull Arena on July 21. Hosted by MLS veteran radio and television announcer Tony Limarzi and former Philadelphia KiXX goalkeeper Peter Pappas, the club will broadcast select matches both home and away through the end of the season.

Formerly the radio play-by-play announcer for D.C. United, Limarzi also works with Comcast SportsNet Mid-Atlantic hosting "D.C. United Central" and "D.C. United Postgame Live" and is also the play-by-play announcer for the University of Maryland Men's Soccer team. Additionally he works with the NBA's Washington Wizards as a studio host for Comcast SportsNet Mid-Atlantic.

The Union returned home defeating Toronto FC, 3-0, on July 8 for their second game of the busy stretch, just days before hosting Sporting Kansas City in the semi-final round of the 2012 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup on July 11.

After the semi-final loss against Sporting Kansas City, the Union only had two days of rest before defeating Eastern Conference foe, the Montreal Impact, 2-1, on July 14 at PPL Park. The Union took on English Premier League's Aston Villa in an international friendly on July 18 in a losing effort 1-0. The busy month for the blue and gold sped up after traveling to New York on July 21 and falling to the Red Bulls 2-0. For most of Saturday night's game at PPL Park, Donovan Ricketts built a wall in front of the Montreal Impact net. In the final ten minutes though, it crumbled.

Fueled by a dramatic stoppage-time goal from captain Carlos Valdés – off a throw-in from Sheanon Williams – the Philadelphia Union knocked off the Montreal Impact, 2-1, in a game that quickly went from lifeless to chaotic.

The Union first got on the board in the 82nd minute, breaking a scoreless deadlock thanks to a brilliant piece of effort from super-sub Antoine Hoppenot, who kept the ball alive along the end line. Lionard Pajoy was the beneficiary of the rookie's hard work, banging home a loose ball right in front of goal.
